On-Line Support Group for Parents

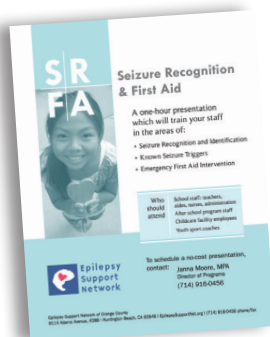
